FAIR PLAY PROGRAM



FAIR PLAY targets aggressive penalties, and the accumulation of penalties by one team in any one game.

- Fair Play holds all players and coaches accountable for their actions and behavior by rewarding proper behavior and good sportsmanship.
- Research has shown that Fair Play increases sportsmanship, accountability, and player safety without compromising hockey's competitive aspects.
- **Under Fair Play in PAHL teams earn a standings point for keeping PIM at 16 or less; teams will lose a standings point for PIM that exceeds 32. See new rule below.**



PAHL FAIR PLAY RULE CHANGE for the 1718 season requires the subtraction of 1 Fair Play point if a team exceeds double their Fair Play PIM threshold of 16 PIM. (PIM over 32 – lose a FPP)

tie = 1 pt
loss = 0 pts

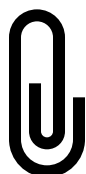

Earn or lose a point based on PIM Criteria

IMPACT OF EARNING A POINT	IMPACT OF LOSING A POINT
win = 3 pts	Win = 1 pts
tie = 2 pts	Tie = 0 pts
loss = 1 pt	Loss = -1 pts

PAHL STANDINGS include Fair Play points.
