

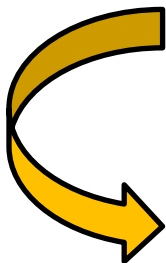

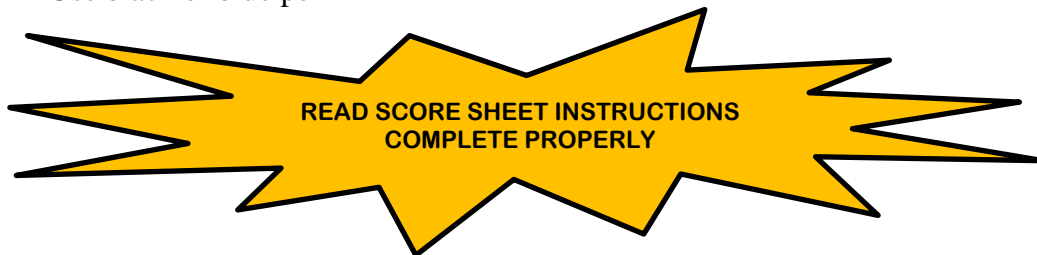
SCORE SHEETS 101

This season all regular season games will again be scored on Pointstreak, and all team stats and standings will be generated by those entries. **However, the USAH official four-part paper score sheets are still required for all games.** This official document will provide your record of the game to input into the Pointstreak system.



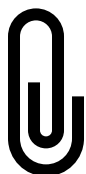
SCORE SHEET COMPLETION INSTRUCTIONS (see below and attached)

- Note that all fields are completed and legible
- The end time may be different than curfew time
- Players not dressed are crossed out on stickers
- Coaches are listed with CEP information
- All required initials and signatures are in place
- Home and away teams are listed by name & team id #
- Use proper rink abbreviations
- Use black or blue pen



GAME SCOREBOX DUTIES are taken care of by the home team. An off ice official is needed to fill out the score sheet, one to run the time clock, and one to process the game in Pointstreak if you are entering during the game. Off ice officials must behave in a professional and neutral fashion for the good of the game. Off ice officials can be removed from the game for poor sportsmanship.

It is a good idea to get as many of your parents involved as you can.
