President John Folmer called the meeting to order at 7:05 pm.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

Secretary John Mudrany was not in attendance.

A reminder was issued that designated voting reps must be in attendance for each association in order to count as present. Reps can be changed twice a year.

September minutes were presented for approval. Motion by Chris Glessner, second by Amy O'Neill. Approved by majority.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Treasurer Rose Hoffmann reported a checking account balance of \$148,665.99 and a savings account balance of \$49,099.86. Reminders have been sent out on outstanding per player fee payments due November 1. The accountant has been paid for services.

The PAHL scholarship application will be out in January. The deadline has been moved earlier to mid March. Awards will be distributed in April.

USAH REPORT

No one was in attendance from USAH / Mid Am.

Associations were reminded that this coming year is a USAH rule change year. Executive Director Darcee Purvis will be attending the USAH Winter Directors meeting and will bring back information on the status of rule changes.

A reminder was also issued on the registration for the Mid Am District PA State Playdown Tournament.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR REPORT

Darcee Purvis reported on the following topics:

1. Fines will be assessed going forward on missing/late score sheets and late Pointstreak game input.

2. Junior team double rostering not permitted under current rules.
3. Pointstreak has been updated with a new referee listing.
4. Outstanding game reschedules need completed. No March games at this point please.
5. New UPMC banner / link on the PAHL website with athlete focused health and nutrition topics.
6. Team book checks will start right after Thanksgiving.
7. The next girls planning meeting is December 6 at RMUS. The agenda focus will be on "age range" modifications.

COMPETITION / PLACEMENT REPORT

Competition Director Jill Harmon recapped the Squirt placement process and results.

Jill also noted that with about 25% of games in to date for all other levels, games are around 80% finishing with a margin of 4 or fewer goals. This is a good competitive standard. Some divisions are in the mid to upper 90%.

Jill reviewed the roster change procedure as written in the PAHL rules.

DISCIPLINE REPORT

Discipline Director Bryan Imler reported that there have been 73 game misconducts so far this season and 4 match penalties.

The penalty leading division at this point is the 14U AA division. Coaches need addressed to work with players.

Penalty levels are being reviewed every week.

Chris Glessner asked for some input on a parent behavior problem. Discussion ensued on zero tolerance enforcement.
