John called meeting to order.

Secretary - Three months of minutes to approve. John asked for motion to approve. Frank Buonomo motion; Mark Baumgartner second. All approved.

Treasurer Report - Savings \$49,098.23. Transferred 10K into this account for the new year. Checking account \$115,048.69. Sent out email for associations with a low balance in their penalty account.

Executive Director - Darcee said scheduling went well. She is asking for an exemption on the 4 team division rule. U16 will play some games against U19 teams. Also talked about new legislation from USA Hockey that prohibits any player that is 12 or younger from being on a national bound team. Approved by all. Girls planning meeting in Oct 4. Discussion on 2 and 2 challenge. Reviewed the challenge with everyone. Emphasized the importance of try hockey for free. Shannon Webster is holding registration open for PAHL organizations. Urged more organizations to enroll. Annual rulebooks and annual guides are available to take tonight. Brochures for head coaches on heads up hockey and concussion symptoms to be handed out as

well. Draft for scheduling will be shared with Presidents and schedulers. No March ice should be brought to scheduling. Playoffs are second weekend in March.

Competition Report - Committee finished PW and Midget reviews last night. Placements will be sent out tonight. Darcee sent out email to all association registrars to thank everyone for help in getting their reports in on time. Every game was reported by the deadline for the first time ever. Appeals will be heard and must be submitted by the president. No coaches can submit their own. Document is available on what is required for the appeal. Only games against PAHL teams will be considered. All appeals must be in no later than 6 PM on Sunday Sept 25. NO EXCEPTIONS!

Discipline - Bryan sent email asking managers to attach a copy of scoresheet when reporting misconducts. These should be reported by the home team or the rink where it occurred.

Rules - Gobbler is mandatory for PAHL play for goaltenders.

Mite Hockey - All coordinators have been addressed that we should not see a coach for disciplinary hearings. We will be asking for Red, White and Blue declarations soon.

Old Business - Crawford needs to pay Sept player fees. Lawrence needs to pay September player fees.

New Business - Ice Mine was purchased and construction is going on. New roof and restaurant. Additional renovations being completed. Ice Connection was purchased as well. New boards, zamboni and flooring. New locker rooms and restaurant. Parking lot is now paved as well. Airport Ice Arena was sold and closed today.
